The expiry date on current insurance certificates is September 30th. The new certificate which you can use from October 1st will be posted to you after September 12th. Please use your new card after this time.

When it has arrived, make sure that all the details such as address, name etc. are displayed correctly. If there is a mistake or if your new card does not arrive, contact the Hoken Nenkin Division or Jumin Fukushi Division in any of city hall's branch offices. Please also check the expiry date. Cards usually have a limit of one year, but this may differ in the following cases: For people turning 75, until the day before their 75th birthday.

In Iga, checkup examinations are available at 18 months (children up until 21 months can take it) and 3 years (for children up to 3 years and 9 months of age). Notifications will be sent out to homes with children eligibile for the checkups. These notifications will be in Japanese, so please bring your letter along with you to City Hall if you need help understanding its content.



The Rules of Garbage Collection Point

Garbage that comes out of the house must be put into the garbage collection point according to the Garbage Collection Calendar or the Garbage Collection Guidebook issued by Iga city.

- ♦ Put out the garbage into the fixed point.
- ♦ Put out the specified kinds of garbage on the fixed day.

♦ Put out the garbage according to the fixed way, like with a correct garbage bag and tying the garbage bags mouth.
